- 2 Awareness Month in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, The most current labor statistics provided by the US
- 4 Department of Labor show only 21.3% of people with disabilities are
- 5 participating in the workforce; and
- 6 Whereas, Twenty-nine percent or almost 1 in 3 adults of
- 7 Michigan residents have developmental disabilities: and
- 8 Whereas, People with developmental disabilities in Michigan

- 1 share with the rest of the states nearly 10 million residents the
- 2 right to work in competitive integrated work environments with
- 3 needed supports while making a living wage; and
- 4 Whereas, The United States Department of Labor has designated
- 5 the 2021 theme for National Disability Employment Month to be
- 6 "America's Recovery: Powered by Inclusion."; and
- 7 Whereas, This theme reflects the commitment to an inclusive
- 8 recovery; and
- 9 Whereas, Those with disabilities deserve to have full and
- 10 complete access to economic opportunity as do all other Americans
- 11 and the accommodations and supports that are required to thrive in
- 12 the workplace; and
- 13 Whereas, Every person should be seen for their ability with
- 14 valuable strengths and their important contributions to their
- 15 community; and
- 16 Whereas, By promoting opportunities for all citizens with
- 17 disabilities in Michigan to gain individual integrated employment
- 18 and engaging businesses to value the contributions that employees
- 19 with disabilities bring to their organizations, we will enhance the
- 20 employment landscape; and
- 21 Whereas, Celebrating the abilities and contributions of the
- 22 people with developmental disabilities can only serve to enrich the
- 23 communities of Michigan and enhance our diversity; now, therefore,
