HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.133

Reps. Cherry, Sneller, Stone, Sowerby, Neeley and Hammoud offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to reaffirm that the University of Michigan

includes the satellite campuses of Dearborn and Flint, and the

3 Board of Regents has an obligation under the Michigan Constitution

4 to provide students at each campus with equitable resources and

5 opportunities.

6 Whereas, Article VIII, Section 4 of the Constitution of the

7 State of Michigan of 1963 provides that the Legislature must

8 appropriate funding to maintain public universities, including the

9 University of Michigan. The state constitution also establishes a

10 Board of Regents that is responsible for supervising University of

11 Michigan institutions and controlling expenditures; and

12 Whereas, The University of Michigan consists of three separate

1 campuses: Ann Arbor, Dearborn, and Flint. While each campus has its

- 2 own history and has received separate state funding in the past,
- 3 all three campuses form the University of Michigan system and are
- 4 controlled and supervised by the same Board of Regents under the
- 5 state constitution; and
- 6 Whereas, While the Board of Regents claims to have the same
- 7 obligations, responsibilities, and missions at each institution,
- 8 students attending the Flint and Dearborn campuses experience
- 9 profound inequity compared to students at the Ann Arbor campus.
- 10 Disparities in funding have led to infrastructure issues at
- 11 Dearborn and Flint facilities and a lack of medical and legal
- 12 services that are currently available for students attending the
- 13 Ann Arbor campus. In addition, students attending the Dearborn and
- 14 Flint campuses lack other opportunities available to Ann Arbor
- 15 students, including the Go Blue Guarantee, which guarantees free
- 16 tuition to students from low-income families; and
- 17 Whereas, Furthermore, there remain pay disparities among
- 18 faculty. Lecturers in Dearborn and Flint make \$7,000 to \$10,000
- 19 less than their counterparts in Ann Arbor. Lecturers, who do the
- 20 majority of teaching in Dearborn and Flint, need a professional
- 21 wage in order to provide students with the energy and resources
- 22 that they deserve; and
- 23 Whereas, The students within the University of Michigan
- 24 system, regardless of campus, should have access to equal resources
- 25 and opportunities, as required by the state constitution; now,
- 26 therefore, be it
- 27 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we reaffirm
- 28 that the University of Michigan includes the satellite campuses of
- 29 Dearborn and Flint; and be it further

- Resolved, That we reaffirm that the Board of Regents has an obligation under the Michigan Constitution to provide students at each campus with equitable resources and opportunities; and be it
- 5 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 6 University of Michigan Board of Regents.
