## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 185

Reps. Sabo and Yaroch offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare October 24-30, 2021, as Fire 2 Prevention Week in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, Last year, home fires killed more than 122 Michigan citizens. According to the National Fire Incident Reporting System, 4 fire departments throughout the state responded to over 13,699 home 6 fires in 2020; and 7 Whereas, According to the latest National Fire Protection 8 Association "Smoke Alarms in the U.S." report, working smoke alarms 9 in the home reduce the risk of dying in a reported fire by more than half. However, almost three out of five home fire deaths occur 10 in homes with no smoke alarms (41 percent) or smoke alarms that 11 12 failed to operate (16 percent), missing or non-functional power 13 sources, including missing or disconnected batteries, dead

- 1 batteries, and disconnected hardwired alarms or other AC power
- 2 issues
- 3 Whereas, Michigan's first responders are dedicated to reducing
- 4 the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through
- 5 prevention, protection, and education so families can take personal
- 6 steps to increase their safety from fire in their homes; and
- 7 Whereas, The 2021 Fire Prevention Month theme, "Learn The
- 8 Sounds of Fire Safety" effectively serves to educate the public
- 9 about the sounds smoke alarms make, what those sounds mean, and how
- 10 to respond to them; now, therefore, be it
- 11 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 12 this legislative body declare October 24-30, 2021, as Fire
- 13 Prevention Week in the state of Michigan. We urge all the people of
- 14 Michigan to educate themselves on and practice cooking safely
- 15 during this observance.
