HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.194

Rep. Anthony offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare November 15-21, 2021, as Recycling 2 Week in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, We all hold the responsibility to future generations to ensure they have the ability and right to live in a clean and 4 sustainable Michigan; and 5 Whereas, Michigan's recycling rate is around only 15% when the 6 7 national recycling rate is 32%; and 8 Whereas, Recycling not only has a positive impact on the environment, but also provides an economic benefit. Research shows 9 that recycling and reuse activities nationwide accounted for 10 681,000 jobs and \$37.8 billion in wages. A 2017 state recycling 11 12 report states that over \$600 million recoverable materials end up 13 in landfills, costing the state of Michigan over 1 billion dollars;

1 and 2 Whereas, In the year 2020, the total waste disposal in Michigan landfills was reported at 52,697,247 cubic yards; and 3 4 Whereas, Recycling conserves resources such as timber, water, 5 and minerals. Recycling protects the environment by reducing the 6 amount of waste in landfills and combustion facilities, as well as 7 the amount of plastic in Michigan's waterways; and 8 Whereas, Approximately 9,887 metric tons of plastic debris per 9 year enter the Laurentian Great Lakes. The Great Lakes make up 10 about 21% of the world's supply of surface fresh water and 84% of 11 North America's surface fresh water; and 12 Whereas, It is estimated that 138,000 new jobs would be created if Michigan's recycling rate tripled to 45%. This would 13 14 provide \$9 billion in annual labor income and \$33.8 billion in 15 economic output. This would also eliminate emission of an 16 additional 7 million metric ton equivalent of carbon dioxide; and 17 Whereas, We celebrate Michiganders' continued dedication to 18 reduce, reuse, and recycle; now, therefore, be it Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 19 20 this legislative body declare November 15-21, 2021, as Recycling Week in the state of Michigan. We demonstrate our state's 21 commitment to sustainability. The act of recycling, both at the 22 23 individual and industrial level, help support a healthier and more
