1	A resolution to declare May 2022 as Mental Health Awareness
2	Month in the state of Michigan.
3	Whereas, The month of May is observed as Mental Health
4	Awareness Month across the United States to educate communities
5	about mental illnesses and reduce the stigma that surrounds them;

7	Whereas, Mental health is essential to everyone's overall
8	health and well-being; and
9	Whereas, All Americans face challenges in life that can impact
10	their mental health; and
11	Whereas, The National Alliance on Mental Illness reports that
12	over 1.3 million adult Michiganders have a mental health condition;

2 Whereas, Prevention is an effective way to reduce the burden3 of mental health conditions; and

Whereas, There are practical tools that all people can use toimprove their mental health and increase resiliency; and

6 Whereas, With effective treatment, those individuals with
7 mental health conditions can recover and lead full, productive
8 lives; and

9 Whereas, By ignoring the illnesses of our fellow citizens, it
10 will only further stigmatize those who suffer from a mental,
11 behavioral, or emotional disorder; and

12 Whereas, Each business, school, government agency, health care 13 provider, organization, and citizen share the burden of mental 14 health problems and has a responsibility to promote mental wellness 15 and support prevention and treatment efforts; now, therefore, be it 16 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 17 this legislative body declare May 2022 as Mental Health Awareness 18 Month in the state of Michigan; and be it further

19 Resolved, That we call upon all citizens, government agencies, 20 public and private institutions, businesses, and schools to commit 21 to increasing the awareness and understanding of mental health, the 22 steps we can take to protect mental health, and the need for 23 appropriate and accessible services for all people with mental 24 health conditions.
