BHT services must be provided under the direction of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA), a qualified Licensed Psychologist (LP) or Limited License Psychologist (LLP), or a master's prepared Qualified Behavioral Health Professional (QBHP).

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities Administration (BHDDA) recently completed a statewide applied behavior analysis provider capacity survey of the PIHP/CMHSP system and is forecasting a provider network shortage that will negatively affect access, quality, and compliance of autism spectrum disorder benefit services.
