This bulletin notifies providers of changes to the enrollment of Master's Limited License Psychologists (LLPs) and Doctoral Educational LLPs. This bulletin also updates information related to the billing of services provided by these providers. Information in this policy is effective January 1, 2020.

Enrollment of LLPs

Individuals licensed as Master's LLPs or Doctoral Educational LLPs who provide services to Medicaid beneficiaries are required to be Medicaid-enrolled providers and be uniquely identified on claims. Throughout this policy, any reference to LLPs pertains to both these provider types unless otherwise stated. Individuals holding Temporary Master's Educational Limited Licenses are not eligible to enroll as Medicaid providers.

To enroll as a Medicaid provider, the LLP must complete an online application in the Community Health Automated Medicaid Processing System (CHAMPS). LLPs should enroll with an individual National Provider Identifier (NPI) and select the "Limited License Psychologist" specialty designation within CHAMPS. LLPs are required to enroll as Rendering Only providers and associate themselves to a billing provider within CHAMPS.

All other current provider qualifications, including licensing requirements, remain unchanged.

Current CHAMPS Enrolled LLPs

A provider specialty labeled "Limited License Psychologist" has been created within CHAMPS to separately identify LLPs from fully licensed psychologists. LLPs currently enrolled within CHAMPS as a "Licensed Psychologist" or enrolled with a specialty of "Limited License

Psychologist-Managed Care Only" will be automatically reassigned by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) to the "Limited License Psychologist" specialty before December 31, 2019. This specialty reassignment does not require managed care only providers to participate with the Medicaid Fee-for-Service program.

LLPs currently enrolled as individual sole proprietors within CHAMPS will be automatically reassigned by MDHHS to a rendering only provider type. LLPs without a current billing provider designation will be contacted by MDHHS Provider Enrollment staff before December 31, 2019 to assist with an assignment. Providers may also initiate the billing provider assignment by contacting Provider Support at 800-292-2550. Billing providers must be enrolled with the program for payment and be designated by December 31, 2019 in order to avoid claim denials.

Billing and Reimbursement for LLP Services

The Medicaid program covers medically necessary psychology services performed by a Medicaid-enrolled LLP, as defined in §18201 of Public Act 368 of 1978. Covered services must be completed under the supervision of a Medicaid enrolled, fully licensed psychologist and are not eligible for direct reimbursement by Medicaid. Reimbursement will be made to the LLP's associated billing provider. The billing provider must have a Group NPI and be enrolled with the Medicaid program for payment.

For dates of service on and after January 1, 2020, Master's LLPs and Doctoral Educational LLPs should no longer bill for services under their supervising psychologist's NPI. Professional claims must include the NPI of the LLP in the Rendering Provider field and the NPI of the supervising psychologist in the Supervising Provider field. Claims submitted without the required NPIs may be denied.

Services performed by Temporary Master's Educational LLPs should continue to be billed under the supervising psychologist. The supervising psychologist must be listed as the Rendering Provider on these claims.

For beneficiaries enrolled in a Medicaid Health Plan or Integrated Care Organization, the provider must check with the beneficiary's health plan for claim completion information.
