Effective for services provided on or after July 13, 2020, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) rescinds allowances granted within Bulletin MSA 20-41 for out-of-state licensed healthcare professionals and nursing students. All other provisions of Bulletin MSA 20-41 related to Private Duty Nursing, Virtual Supervisory Visits, and Prior Authorization for Private Duty Nursing remain intact until further notice.

The purpose of this policy is to rescind portions of Bulletin MSA 20-41 that are specific to provisions of Executive Order 2020-61. Executive Order 2020-61 was rescinded by Executive order 2020-150 on July 13, 2020.

Effective for services provided on or after July 13, 2020, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) rescinds the following provisions within Bulletin MSA 20-41:

Out-of-State Licensed Healthcare Professionals

Allowance granted by MSA 20-41 for out-of-state nurses (registered nurse [RN], licensed practical nurse [LPN]), physical therapists (PT), occupational therapists (OT), and speech-language pathologists (SLP) to practice in Michigan under a Medicaid-enrolled hospice agency will be end-dated July 13, 2020. This includes out-of-state retired healthcare professionals (RN, LPN, PT, OT, and SLP).

Nursing Students (RN, LPN)

Allowance granted by MSA 20-41 for nursing students (RN, LPN) enrolled in accredited nursing programs to become licensed, registered, or certified health care professionals to volunteer or be employed by a Medicaid-enrolled hospice agency will be end-dated July 13, 2020.

All other provisions of Bulletin MSA 20-41 related to Private Duty Nursing, Virtual Supervisory Visits, and Prior Authorization for Private Duty Nursing remain intact until further notice.
