

The rules are designed  
to provide a stand-  
ardized method for  
law enforcement,  
adult protective ser-  
vices, and financial  
institutions to pro-  
vide notice of re-  
ports of suspected  
or detected covered  
financial exploitation  
made by financial in-  
stitutions to the  
county prosecutor.  
The rules provide  
forms with a descrip-  
tion of required con-  
tent that shall be in-  
cluded in notifica-  
tions to the county  
prosecutor and pro-  
vide guidelines for  
financial institutions  
to determine in  
which county to con-  
tact the county  
prosecutor and how  
to obtain contact in-  
formation for each  
prosecutor's office.  
They also seek to  
avoid confusion  
when multiple law  
enforcement agen-  
cies receive copies  
of a single notifica-  
tion from a financial  
institution by requir-  
ing each law en-  
forcement agency  
that receives a copy  
to make a report to  
the county  
prosecutor's office.  
The rules are  
designed to create  
the least burden-  
some alternative for  
those required to  
comply, as the re-  
quired notification  
forms are each only  
a single page which  
permits reports al-  
ready required to be  
generated in the or-  
dinary course of  
business by the  
agencies making the  
notifications as at-  
tachments.

By the authority con-  
ferred on the  
Department of At-  
torney General under ¶  
5(5) and ¶ 5(6) of  
the Financial Exploi-  
tation Prevention Act  
of 2020. ¶ 5(5)  
states that if a law  
enforcement agency  
or adult protective  
services receives a  
report of suspected  
or detected covered  
financial exploitation  
from a financial in-  
stitution, the agency  
receiving the report  
must provide notifi-  
cation to the county  
prosecutor within 10

days of receiving the  
report. ¶ 5(6) states  
that if a financial in-  
stitution that makes  
a report of suspect-  
ed or detected  
covered financial ex-  
ploitation is unable  
to communicate with  
law enforcement or  
adult protective ser-  
vices or does not re-  
ceive required  
follow-up notifica-  
tions from law en-  
forcement or adult  
protective services,  
the financial institu-  
tion may provide no-  
tification to the  
county prosecutor.  
Both ¶5(5) and ¶  
5(6) require that the  
manner of notifica-  
tion to the county  
prosecutor's office  
be made in a  
manner prescribed  
by the attorney gen-  
eral. MCL  
487.2085(5); MCL  
487.2085(6). The  
proposed rules will  
take effect immedi-  
ately after filing with  
the Secretary of  
State. The proposed





The Department of Attorney General will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on proposed changes to the Financial Exploitation Prevention Act rule set.

The rules are designed to provide a standardized method for law enforcement, adult protective services, and financial institutions to provide notice of reports of suspected or detected covered financial exploitation made by financial institutions to the county prosecutor. The rules provide forms with a description of required content that shall be included in notifications to the county prosecutor and provide guidelines for financial institutions to determine in which county to contact the county prosecutor and how to obtain contact information for each prosecutor's office. They also seek to avoid confusion when multiple law enforcement agencies receive copies of a single notification from a financial institution by requiring each law enforcement agency that receives a copy to make a report to the county prosecutor's office. The rules are designed to create the least burdensome alternative for those required to comply, as the required notification forms are each only a single page which permits reports already required to be generated in the ordinary course of business by the agencies making the notifications as attachments.

By the authority conferred on the Department of Attorney General under § 5(5) and § 5(6) of the Financial Exploitation Prevention Act of 2020. § 5(5) states that if a law enforcement agency or adult protective services receives a report of suspected or detected covered financial exploitation from a financial institution, the agency receiving the report must provide notification to the county prosecutor within 10 days of receiving the report. § 5(6) states that if a financial institution that makes a report of suspected or detected covered financial exploitation is unable to communicate with law enforcement or adult protective services or does not receive required follow-up notifications from law enforcement or adult protective services, the financial institution may provide notification to the county prosecutor. Both § 5(5) and § 5(6) require that the manner of notification to the county prosecutor's office be made in a manner prescribed by the attorney general. MCL 487.2085(5); MCL 487.2085(6). The proposed rules will take effect immediately after filing with the Secretary of State. The proposed rules are published on the State of Michigan web site at <http://www.michigan.gov/ARD> and in the Michigan Register in the 7/1/2021 issue. 


