BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2021-77 LR would make numerous additions, amendments, and rescissions to rules pertaining to electric utility service provided by utilities that are under the Public Service Commission's (PSC) jurisdiction. Provisions included in the rule set would add new definitions, including defining the terms "major interruption" and "sustained interruption"; require electric utilities and cooperatives with more than 100,000 customers to submit a quarterly line clearing report to the PSC; require electric utilities and cooperatives to submit a solid-state meter annual report; update requirements regarding cybersecurity incident reporting; update requirements regarding meter reading; add additional requirements for electric utility and cooperative line clearance programs; require electric utilities and cooperatives to develop, implement, and maintain a cybersecurity program; and clarify existing language and remove obsolete language.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2021-77 LR would not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or on any other unit of state or local government.

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
