BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2022-21 LR would make several amendments to rules pertaining to homes for the aged. The rule set would address obsolete rules and comply with statutory requirements, specifically MCL 333.20171. Specific changes would include revisions to definitions, revisions pertaining to the reporting of incidents and quality review programs, and revisions pertaining to residents' medications.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2022-21 LR is anticipated to result in modest labor savings for the Bureau of Community and Health Systems, but LARA does not anticipate any associated cost reduction. The department projects that labor savings would be achieved due to changes in incident report reviews and field staff investigations. Labor savings resulting from these changes would be shifted to other priorities, including timely routine inspections; therefore, costs would remain at current levels. The rule set would not affect the expenditures or revenues of any other state or local government units.

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
