FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed rules would have a minimal fiscal impact on the State and no fiscal impact on local units of government. Any additional costs would be to training staff and update manuals, which is likely to be supported with current appropriations. The rules are unlikely to change the amount of revenue generated by charitable gaming. Any amount not used to support the Michigan Gaming Control Board is lapsed to the General Fund at the end of the fiscal year. Beginning in FY 2023-24, Millionaire Party Regulation will be entirely supported with Internet Gaming Fund revenue. Therefore, all annual revenue generated from Millionaire Party gaming would be lapsed to the General Fund.
