## BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

The Department of Health and Human Services is responsible for collecting data on illness and disease and reporting the findings to the federal Centers for Disease Control. These rule changes would establish a standard for collecting and reporting data on occurrences of chronic disease in this state.

## FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

These rule changes would likely have no fiscal impact on the state or local units of government. The CDC collects these data from states regardless of a federal mandate. The intent of these changes is to collect the pertinent data using existing reporting infrastructure, such as the electronic health record exchange.

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
