FISCAL IMPACT: The proposed rule change would have a negative impact on State government and no impact on local government. Extending the license validity period to three years would likely result in revenue losses, as licensees pay statutorily controlled license fees (under Part 161 of the Public Health Code) less frequently; however, the actual revenue loss would depend on the exact renewal date of each licensee and the number of individuals pursuing licenses in each time period.
