The purpose of this bulletin is to update Medicaid plans that cover Targeted Case Management - Recuperative Care.

Effective July 1, 2025, MI Health Link will provide coverage for beneficiaries seeking admission to a recuperative care provider. These beneficiaries will follow the same process that is used by Medicaid Health Plans. Prior authorization must be obtained from the MDHHS Program Review Division for room and board, and the Integrated Care Organization (ICO) must be contacted for prior authorization for care coordination. (Refer to the MDHHS Medicaid Provider Manual, Special Programs chapter, Targeted Case Management - Recuperative Care section for more information.)

When the beneficiary is enrolled in an ICO, the ICO care coordinator and the recuperative care provider are expected to collaborate with each other for continuity of care purposes, and to avoid duplication of care coordination services.
