RE: JCAR No. 25-38 (MOAHR No. 2023-059 HS) – Body Art Facilities

Dear Ms. Brennan:

As Chair and Alternate Chair of the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, it has come to our attention that the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services is asking for permission to withdraw the proposed rules identified as "Body Art Facilities" (JCAR No. 25-38; MOAHR No. 2023-059 HS) as described in your letter dated March 18, 2025.

In accordance with MCL 24.245a(10), a rule is withdrawn with permission if the withdrawal is approved by the Chair and Alternate Chair. This section further provides that if permission to withdraw is granted, the 15-session-day period for committee review is tolled until the rule is resubmitted, subject to the requirement that the committee must have at least 6 session days after resubmission to consider the resubmitted rules.

On behalf of the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules and in accordance with the authority of the Chair and Alternate Chair under MCL 24.245a(10), we grant permission to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services to withdraw the proposed rules.
