BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2023-080 LR would create rules pertaining to private security guard and security alarm agencies. Currently, no such rules exist. The proposed rules include the following: 1) definitions, 2) requirements for agency names, uniforms, badges, and vehicles, and 3) requirements for business supervision and employer and employee responsibilities.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2023-080 LR would have minimal to no fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. The department indicated that there could be cost savings resulting from less staff time spent on reviewing for compliance with existing statute.
