FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed rule change would have a minor positive fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. The Department has estimated that the initial number of applicants would result in approximately \$20,000 in revenue from license and application processing fees, and that these fees then are expected to generate about \$9,000 annually. However, much of this revenue increase would be offset by the initial and ongoing costs of administering the licensure program. The Department has estimated that the initial implementation costs would total approximately \$20,000, while ongoing costs are estimated at about \$6,000 annually.
