5 MR. MacINTOSH: Good morning. My name is
6 Weston MacIntosh and I am an analyst for the Bureau of
7 Professional Licensing in the Department of Licensing and
8 Regulatory Affairs, and I will be facilitating the
9 hearing today.

10 This is a public hearing on proposed
11 administrative rules entitled "Cosmetology - General
12 Rules" and "Professional Surveyors - General Rules." The
13 hearing is being conducted under the authority of the
14 Administrative Procedures Act, Public Act 306 of 1969, on
15 behalf of the Department of Licensing and Regulatory
16 Affairs, Bureau of Professional Licensing.

17 This hearing is being called to order at
18 9:00 a.m. on December 17, 2019, at the G. Mennen Williams
19 Building Auditorium located at 525 West Ottawa Street in
20 Lansing, Michigan. The notice of public hearing was
21 published in three newspapers of general circulation, the
22 Grand Rapids Press and the Flint Journal on December 1,
23 2019, and the Mining Journal on December 3, 2019, as well
24 as The Michigan Register, Issue No. 22, published on
25 December 15, 2019.

1 We are here today to receive your comments
2 on the proposed rules. If you wish to speak, please make
3 sure you have signed in and indicated your willingness to
4 speak. You may use the cards provided in the lobby for
5 this purpose. I will organize the cards by rule set so
6 that the comments for that profession will be grouped
7 together in the transcript. If you would like to testify
8 and have not signed in, please do so now. For those of
9 you who do not wish to sign in with a card, you may speak
10 at the microphone once we have exhausted the stack of
11 cards submitted to me.

12 If you have comments, please make sure
13 that they related directly to the proposed rules. If you
14 have questions regarding the rules, please submit your
15 questions as part of your testimony for the Department's
16 review. If you have suggested changes to the proposed
17 rules, please include the specific reasons why the
18 changes would be in the public interest.

19 For the record, when you testify, please
20 identify yourself by spelling your name and organization,
21 if any, that you may be speaking for today. This will
22 help the Department prepare the hearing record that will
23 go before the Boards. Written statements can be
24 submitted directly to me at the table. The Department
25 will also accept written statements emailed or postmarked

1 MPAs anymore. Are we going to do theory and practical or
2 both?

3 MR. MacINTOSH: Do you have any other
4 questions? We're not necessarily answering your
5 questions today. I mean this is your opportunity to make
6 comments and raise any issues or concerns that you have
7 with the rules.

8 MS. EHRKE: I mean I don't have any
9 problem getting rid of the MPAs, but are we going to
10 still be logging theory and practical hours?

11 MR. MacINTOSH: Do you have any other --

12 MS. EHRKE: No. Thank you.

13 MR. MacINTOSH: O.K. Next I have -- Do
14 we have any other comments or questions or concerns as
15 far as Cosmetology? (No response.)

16 So we'll move on to Professional
17 Surveyors. I have Brett Dodge.

18 MR. DODGE: That's correct. Good
19 morning. My name is Brett Dodge, B-r-e-t-t, D-o-d-g-e,
20 with the Michigan Society of Professional Surveyors. We
21 have no comments at this time.

22 MR. MacINTOSH: Is there any other
23 comments on either rule set at this time? (No response.)

24 So what we'll do is, as there's no other
25 comments, we're going to take a short recess. We'll

1 probably wait 15 more minutes to see if there's any other
2 comments or questions, and then we'll go back on the
3 record. So we'll stop right now and wait.

4 (Approximate 15-minute recess was taken.)

5 MR. MacINTOSH: If there are no other
6 comments at this time, I hereby declare the hearing
7 closed. The record will remain open until today at 5:00
8 o'clock p.m. for any additional comments you may wish to
9 share regarding the proposed rules. Thank you for
10 coming.
