**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The rule would have a negative fiscal impact on the State and local government. New misdemeanor arrests and convictions under the proposed rule changes could increase resource demands on law enforcement, court systems, community supervision, and jails. However, it is unknown how many people would be prosecuted under provisions of the bill. Any additional revenue from imposed fines would go to local libraries.

The rule would have no fiscal impact on the Department of Health and Human Services.
