BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2021-19 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to architects and the architecture profession. Specifically, the rule set would: include typographical revisions and corrections, update accreditation standards for architecture education programs, revise experience requirements for licensure, clarify the requirements for the design and use of an architect's seal, and update language regarding continuing education activities.
