Subject: RESUBMISSION: Michigan Office of Administrative Hearing and Rules (MOAHR) Administrative Rules Division No. 2020 HS-Child Caring Institutions; JCAR No 21-69

## Gentlemen:

Pursuant to MCL 24.245a(10)(a), the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is resubmitting its amended rule set for your review. The rules are limited to the dangerous practice of restraint and seclusion of vulnerable children. The promulgation of these rules will provide direction to the child caring institutions for the reduction and elimination of restraint and seclusion. Further, the final rules place DHHS in compliance with the corrective action plan entered on April 26, 2022, by the federal court in *Dwayne B., et al v Snyder, et al.*, No. 2:06-cv-13548 (ED Mich 2006) that prohibits the restraint and seclusion of children in child caring institutions.

DHHS respectfully requests a waiver of the additional six session days under MCL 24.245a(10) to meet the federal court's deadline of June 1, 2022.
