The Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on proposed changes to the Historic Tax Credit Certification rule set.

The proposed rules (2021-82 LE) will provide guidance and the procedures by which a taxpayer may submit an application, rehabilitation plan or request for tax certification of a completed rehabilitation of a historic resource.
