BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

The federal government through the Federal Endangered Species Act has delegated the regulation of the state's endangered and threatened wildlife and plants to Michigan through the Department of Natural Resources (DNR). The department must maintain administrative rules in accordance with the Federal List of Endangered and Threatened Wildlife Plants. These proposed revisions to Part 365 of NREPA would allow DNR to remain in compliance with these standards and prevent duplicate or contradictory regulations.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

It is unlikely that the proposed rules would affect costs or revenue for DNR. These changes are also unlikely to affect costs or revenues for local units of government.
