FISCAL IMPACT:

The final rule set would have no significant fiscal impact on the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and no fiscal impact on local units of government. The rule set would update the current list of endangered and threatened species in Michigan, which was established under Public Act 451 of 1994, Part 365 prohibiting the taking of all endangered and threatened species identified in the rule set. The DNR is required under MCL 324.36503(1-2) to promulgate rules listing all endangered or threatened species in Michigan and to review and amend the list as necessary every two years.

Funding for the research and management of designated endangered and threatened species is appropriated to the nongame fish and wildlife trust fund. The rule set would not result in any significant increase or decrease in the use of those funds and no other costs for the department would be associated with the final rule set. Additionally, no significant impact on costs or revenues for local units of government would likely occur as a result of the proposed rule set.
