

Rules Before JCAR as of June 6, 2025**

JCAR 25-38 (MOAHR No. 2023-059 HS) Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Administration - Body Art Facilities. These rules were originally submitted to JCAR on March 13, 2025, and withdrawn with permission on April 8, 2025. The rules were resubmitted to JCAR on May 21, 2025. The last day for JCAR consideration is 15 session days from submission.

JCAR 25-43 (MOAHR No. 2024-053 LR) Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Professional Licensing - Physician's Assistants - General Rules. These rules were submitted to JCAR on May 1, 2025. The last day for JCAR consideration is 15 session days from submission.

JCAR 25-44 (MOAHR No. 2023-015 EQ) Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy, Air Quality Division - Part 10. Intermittent Testing and Sampling. These rules were submitted to JCAR on May 20, 2025. The last day for JCAR consideration is 15 session days from submission.

JCAR 25-45 (MOAHR No. 2022-064 ST) Department of State, Elections and Campaign Finance - Electronic Return of Absent Voter Ballots by Eligible Voters. These rules were submitted to JCAR on May 21, 2025. The last day for JCAR consideration is 15 session days from submission.

JCAR 25-46 (MOAHR No. 2024-060 LR) Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Professional Licensing - Sanitarians Registration - General Rules. These rules were submitted to JCAR on June 3, 2025. The last day for JCAR consideration is 15 session days from submission.

How to Determine the Number of Session Days Left for JCAR Review of Rules**

Under MCL 24.245a, the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules generally has 15 session days to act on a set of rules submitted to the committee. To determine when that time will expire for a set of rules that you are interested in, do the following:

1. Determine the date the rules were submitted to JCAR.
2. Determine how many session days there have been since then.
A session day is defined in MCL 24.245a(13) as a day in which both houses of the legislature convene and record a

quorum. You can determine this yourself by checking the journals here:

If 15 session days have passed and JCAR has not taken up the rules, the rules are probably no longer before JCAR, and have been or will soon be submitted to the Secretary of State and take effect.

Please note that under MCL 24.245a(12), a rule pending before the committee at the final adjournment of a regular session held in an even-numbered year must be withdrawn and resubmitted to the committee during the next session, at which point a new and untolled 15-session-day period begins.

Below is our list of days this session* on which both houses have convened and recorded a quorum. Please note that this is not an official list. We have done our best to prepare an accurate list, and we will attempt to update it regularly. If you see any mistakes, please let us know.
