The Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on proposed changes to the Uniform System of Accounts for Major and Nonmajor Electric Utilities rule set.

The proposed rules adopt by reference updates to the federal Uniform System of Accounts (USofA) for Major and Nonmajor Electric Utilities promulgated by the U.S. Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). Specifically, on October 23, 2023, FERC issued a final rule amending the USofA to, among other things, create new accounts for wind, solar, and other renewable generating assets. The proposed rules adopt the changes in this final rule that go into effect on January 1, 2025.

By authority conferred on the Michigan Public Service Commission by section 5 of 1919 PA 419, MCL 460.55.

The proposed rules will take effect 1/1/2025 after filing with the Secretary of State. The proposed rules are published on the State of Michigan's website at [www.michigan.gov/ARD](http://www.michigan.gov/ARD) and in the 9/1/2024 issue of the Michigan Register.
