¹The information contained in this table only details the membership of the Michigan house of representatives for the session years 1991-2000. It is not necessarily indicative of the total length of service of any one member in the house.

With respect to limitations on terms of office of state representatives, the state constitution provides, in relevant part, that "[n]o person shall be elected to the office of state representative more than three times . . . Any person appointed or elected to fill a vacancy in the house of representatives . . . for a period greater than one half of a term of such office, shall be considered to have been elected to serve one time in that office . . . This limitation on the number of times a person shall be elected to office shall apply to terms of office beginning on or after January 1, 1993." Const 1963, art 4, § 54.

²The decennial reapportionment of Michigan house of representative districts was approved May 21, 1982. Implementation of the reapportionment plan resulted in a change in the district number of eighteen representatives (Brotherton, Garamitaro, DeBeaussiaert, Evans, Fitzpatrick, Gilmer, Kilpatrick, Mahalak, McNamee, McNeely, Muxlow, Padden, Scott, S. Stopczynski, Strand, Trim, Van Singel, Watkins) whose service spanned that period. Those changes became effective for the November 1982 general election.

The decennial reapportionment of the Michigan house of representatives was approved on April 1, 1992, and became effective for the November 1992 general election. For each member who served in the 87th Legislature as well as in the 86th Legislature, his or her district number under the 1982 plan is shown first in the District column of the table, followed by his or her district number under the 1992 plan, provided the district number was changed under the 1992 plan.
