THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 7104 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7104.

2 (E) ~~(d)~~—"Firearm" means a weapon from which a dangerous
3 projectile may be propelled by an explosive, or by gas or air.
4 Firearm does not include a smooth bore rifle or handgun designed
5 and manufactured exclusively for propelling by a spring, or by gas
6 or air, BBs not exceeding .177 caliber.

7 (F) ~~(e)~~—"Pistol" means a loaded or unloaded firearm that is 26
8 inches or less in length, or a loaded or unloaded firearm that by
9 its construction and appearance conceals itself as a firearm.

10 (G) ~~(f)~~—"Purchaser" means a person who receives a pistol from
11 another person by purchase, gift, or loan.

12 (H) ~~(g)~~—"Seller" means a person who sells, furnishes, loans,
13 or gives a pistol to another person.

14 (I) ~~(h)~~—"Shotgun" means a firearm designed or redesigned, made
15 or remade, and intended to be fired from the shoulder and designed
16 or redesigned and made or remade to use the energy of the explosive
17 in a fixed shotgun shell to fire through a smooth bore either a
18 number of ball shot or a single projectile for each single function
19 of the trigger.

20 (J) ~~(i)~~—"Short-barreled shotgun" means a shotgun having 1 or
21 more barrels less than 18 inches in length or a weapon made from a
22 shotgun, whether by alteration, modification, or otherwise, if the
23 weapon as modified has an overall length of less than 26 inches.

24 (K) ~~(j)~~—"Rifle" means a firearm designed or redesigned, made
25 or remade, and intended to be fired from the shoulder and designed
26 or redesigned and made or remade to use the energy of the explosive
27 in a fixed metallic cartridge to fire only a single projectile

1 through a rifled bore for each single pull of the trigger.

2 (I) ~~(k)~~—"Short-barreled rifle" means a rifle having 1 or more
3 barrels less than 16 inches in length or a weapon made from a
4 rifle, whether by alteration, modification, or otherwise, if the
5 weapon as modified has an overall length of less than 26 inches.

6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
7 unless House Bill No. 5091 of the 97th Legislature is enacted into
8 law.
