## HOUSE BILL NO. 4959

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 139 (MCL 750.139), as amended by 1998 PA 510.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 139. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a A child
- 2 under 16-18 years of age while under arrest, confinement, or
- 3 conviction for any A crime shall not be placed in any AN
- 4 apartment or cell of any A prison or place of confinement with any
- 5 adult 1 OR MORE ADULTS who is ARE under arrest, confinement, or
- 6 conviction for any A crime, or be permitted to remain in any court
- 7 room during the trial of adults, or be transported in any A vehicle
- 8 of transportation in company USED TO TRANSPORT INMATES with adults
- 9 charged with or convicted of A crime.
- 10 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to prisoners being
- 11 transported to or from, or confined in a youth correctional

- 1 facility operated by the department of corrections or a private
- 2 vendor under section 20g of 1953 PA 232, MCL 791.220g.
- 3 (2)  $\frac{3}{100}$  All cases involving the commitment or trial of
- 4 children under 16-18 years of age for any crime or misdemeanor,
- 5 before any court, shall be heard and determined by the court at a
- 6 suitable time, to be designated by it, DESIGNATED BY THE COURT,
- 7 separate and apart from the trial of other criminal cases.
- 8 (3)  $\frac{(4)}{Any}$  A person who violates this section is guilty of a
- 9 misdemeanor.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 12 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
