21 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

22 GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year

- 1 ending September 30, 2017 is \$4,000,000.00 and state appropriations
- 2 paid to local units of government are \$3,000,000.00.
- 3 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
- 4 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
- 5 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
- 6 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
- 7 to 18.1594.

8 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

- 9 Sec. 301. The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for the
- 10 water infrastructure improvements for the nation act program are
- 11 considered work project appropriations, and any unencumbered or
- 12 unalloted funds are carried forward into the succeeding fiscal
- 13 year. The following is in compliance with section 451a(1) of the
- 14 management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:
- 15 (a) The purpose of the projects to be carried forward is to
- 16 provide water infrastructure improvements.
- (b) The projects will be accomplished by contract.
- 18 (c) The total estimated cost of all projects is
- **19** \$100,000,000.00.
- 20 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2021.

21 LEGISLATURE

- 22 Sec. 401. The funds appropriated in part 1 for the State
- 23 Capitol Historic Site shall be used to reimburse the senate and
- 24 house of representatives for a transfer that was used for Capitol
- 25 improvements.

TECHNOLOGY, MANAGEMENT, AND BUDGET

- 2 Sec. 501. (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1 for the
- 3 sinkhole declaration of emergency, the department of technology,
- 4 management, and budget shall allocate funds to address needs
- 5 related to the declaration of emergency issued on January 6, 2017.
- 6 These funds shall support emergency long-term bypass pumping, which
- 7 includes, but is not limited to, electrical, piping, road
- 8 crossings, and traffic control.
- 9 (2) Funding, described in subsection (1), shall be expended to
- 10 protect public health, safety, and property, including protection
- 11 of the Great Lakes, and to lessen or avert the threat of more
- 12 severe and long-lasting impact to the community and its water
- 13 environment.

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
