## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4381

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending sections 74116 and 78119 (MCL 324.74116 and 324.78119),
section 74116 as amended by 2016 PA 1 and section 78119 as amended
by 2013 PA 81.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 74116. (1) Subject to subsection (4), the operator of a
- 2 nonresident motor vehicle or commercial motor vehicle shall not
- 3 enter any state park with that motor vehicle unless a valid motor
- 4 vehicle park permit issued under section 74117 is affixed to the
- 5 lower right-hand corner of the windshield. An annual motor vehicle
- 6 park permit for a nonresident motor vehicle shall be affixed
- 7 permanently for that year. The department shall post signs at parks
- 8 that state that a motor vehicle park permit is required for entry

- 1 by a nonresident motor vehicle or commercial motor vehicle.
- 2 (2) Subject to subsection (4), the operator of a resident
- 3 motor vehicle shall not enter a state park with the resident motor
- 4 vehicle unless the recreation passport fee has been paid for that
- 5 motor vehicle. Payment of the recreation passport fee authorizes
- 6 entry into all state parks and recreation areas and designated
- 7 state-operated public boating access sites until expiration of the
- 8 motor vehicle registration.
- 9 (3) Subject to subsection (4), if the secretary of state
- 10 issues registration tabs or stickers as described in section 805 of
- 11 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.805, the operator
- 12 of a resident motor vehicle shall not enter a state park with the
- 13 resident motor vehicle unless the resident motor vehicle has a
- 14 registration tab or sticker marked as provided under that section
- 15 to show that the recreation passport fee has been paid FOR THAT
- 16 MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 17 (4) Subsections (1) to (3) do not apply under any of the
- 18 following circumstances:
- 19 (a) While the motor vehicle is being driven or parked within
- 20 an established federal OR state or county highway OR COUNTY
- 21 ROAD within a state park.
- 22 (b) If the motor vehicle is used in the operation or
- 23 maintenance of a state park, is an emergency motor vehicle, is a
- 24 state owned or law enforcement motor vehicle, or is a private motor
- 25 vehicle being operated on official state business.
- (c) If the motor vehicle is registered under section 803e(1)
- 27 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.803e, and is

- 1 exempt under section 803e(6) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA
- 2 300, MCL 257.803e, from the registration tax, or if the motor
- 3 vehicle is registered under AS DESCRIBED IN section 217d or 803f of
- 4 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.217d and 257.803f.
- 5 (d) At a state-operated public boating access site or a state
- 6 park where there is an opportunity to fish on a day that the
- 7 department has designated as a free winter fishing day or a free
- 8 fishing day under section 43534.
- 9 (e) If and to the extent that the department waives the
- 10 requirements for department-sponsored events or other circumstances
- 11 as determined by the director or the director's designee.
- Sec. 78119. (1) Subject to subsection (4), a person shall not
- 13 enter, in a nonresident motor vehicle or commercial motor vehicle,
- 14 a state-operated public boating access site designated under
- 15 section 78105(2) without a valid pass affixed to the lower right-
- 16 hand corner of the windshield. A seasonal pass shall be affixed
- 17 permanently for the season.
- 18 (2) Subject to subsection (4), the operator of a resident
- 19 motor vehicle shall not enter a state-operated public boating
- 20 access site designated under section 78105(2) with the resident
- 21 motor vehicle unless the recreation passport fee has been paid for
- 22 that motor vehicle. Payment of the recreation passport fee
- 23 authorizes entry into all state parks and recreation areas and
- 24 designated state-operated public boating access sites until
- 25 expiration of the motor vehicle registration.
- 26 (3) Subject to subsection (4), if the secretary of state
- 27 issues registration tabs or stickers as described in section 805 of

- 1 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.805, the operator
- 2 of a resident motor vehicle shall not enter a designated state-
- 3 operated public boating access site with the resident motor vehicle
- 4 unless the resident motor vehicle has a registration tab or sticker
- 5 marked as provided under that section to show that the recreation
- 6 passport fee has been paid FOR THAT MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 7 (4) Subsections (1) to (3) do not apply under any of the
- 8 following circumstances:
- **9** (a) If the motor vehicle is used in the operation or
- 10 maintenance of the public boating access site, is an emergency
- 11 motor vehicle, is a state-owned or law enforcement motor vehicle,
- 12 or is a private motor vehicle being operated on official state
- 13 business.
- **14** (b) If the motor vehicle is registered under section 803e(1)
- of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.803e, and is
- 16 exempt under section 803e(6) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA
- 17 300, MCL 257.803e, from the registration tax, or if the motor
- 18 vehicle is registered under—AS DESCRIBED IN section 217d or 803f of
- 19 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.217d and 257.803f.
- (c) If and to the extent the department waives the
- 21 requirements for department-sponsored events or other circumstances
- 22 as determined by the director or the director's designee.
- 23 (5) A person who violates subsection (1), (2), or (3) is
- 24 responsible for a state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay
- 25 a civil fine of not more than \$100.00. A person shall not be cited
- 26 for a violation of both subsections (2) and (3) for the same
- 27 incident.

- (6) In any proceeding for the violation of this part or a rule 1
- 2 promulgated under this part, if a motor vehicle is found parked in
- a designated state-operated public boating access site, the 3
- 4 registration plate displayed on the motor vehicle constitutes prima
- facie evidence that the owner of the motor vehicle was the person 5
- who parked or placed it at the location where it was found. 6
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect February 7
- 19, 2019. 8
- Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect 9
- 10 unless House Bill No. 4380 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into
- 11 law.
