SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4881

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 225 (MCL 257.225), as amended by 2014 PA 26.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 225. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection
- 2 and subsection (6), a registration plate issued for a vehicle shall
- 3 be attached to the rear of the vehicle. A registration plate issued
- 4 for a truck tractor or road tractor shall be attached to the front
- 5 of the vehicle.
- 6 (2) A-SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (7), A registration plate shall at
- 7 all times be securely fastened in a horizontal position to the
- 8 vehicle for which the plate is issued so as to prevent the plate
- 9 from swinging. The plate shall be attached at a height of not less
- 10 than 12 inches from the ground, measured from the bottom of the

- 1 plate, in a place and position that is clearly visible. The plate
- 2 shall be maintained free from foreign materials that obscure or
- 3 partially obscure the registration information and in a clearly
- 4 legible condition.
- 5 (3) A registration plate or an expiration tab on the
- 6 registration plate shall be of a different color designated by the
- 7 secretary of state with a marked contrast between the color of the
- 8 registration plate and the numerals or letters on the plate. The
- 9 secretary of state may provide a distinctive registration plate as
- 10 a replacement for a standard plate. To honor a special or
- 11 historical event, the secretary of state may provide a
- 12 commemorative plate as a replacement for a standard plate.
- 13 (4) A person shall not attach a name plate, insignia, or
- 14 advertising device to a registration plate in a manner that
- 15 obscures or partially obscures the registration information.
- 16 (5) A person shall not operate a motor vehicle that has a name
- 17 plate, insignia, or advertising device attached to a registration
- 18 plate in a manner that obscures or partially obscures the
- 19 registration information.
- 20 (6) A registration plate issued for a historic military
- 21 vehicle that is authorized to be operated on the roads of this
- 22 state is not required to be attached to the rear or the front of
- 23 the historic military vehicle unless the historic military vehicle
- 24 was originally manufactured with lighting and mounting provisions
- 25 for a registration plate. However, if the registration plate is not
- 26 attached to the exterior of the historic military vehicle, it shall
- 27 be present in the historic military vehicle to which it refers and

- 1 shall be made available upon demand of a police officer. As used in
- 2 this subsection, "historic military vehicle" means a vehicle,
- 3 including a trailer, regardless of the vehicle's size, weight, or
- 4 year of manufacture, that was manufactured for use in any country's
- 5 military forces and is maintained to represent its military design
- 6 and markings accurately.
- 7 (7) THE ATTACHMENT OF A TOW BALL, BICYCLE RACK, REMOVABLE
- 8 HITCH, OR OTHER DEVICE DESIGNED TO CARRY AN OBJECT ON THE REAR OF A
- 9 VEHICLE, INCLUDING THE OBJECT BEING CARRIED, DOES NOT OBSCURE OR
- 10 PARTIALLY OBSCURE THE REGISTRATION PLATE IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION
- 11 (2).
- 12 (8) (7)—A person who violates this section is responsible for
- 13 a civil infraction.
- 14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 15 after the date it is enacted into law.
