SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 5209

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding sections 484b and 956b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 484B. AN ORGANIZATION SHALL NOT EMPLOY AN INDIVIDUAL TO
- 2 CIRCULATE OR OBTAIN SIGNATURES ON A BALLOT QUESTION PETITION
- 3 PROPOSING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT, INITIATION OF LEGISLATION, OR
- 4 REFERENDUM OF LEGISLATION IF THAT INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF
- 5 AN ELECTION CRIME, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ELECTION FRAUD OR
- 6 FORGERY.
- 7 SEC. 956B. AN ORGANIZATION SHALL NOT EMPLOY AN INDIVIDUAL TO
- 8 CIRCULATE OR OBTAIN SIGNATURES ON A RECALL PETITION IF THAT
- 9 INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF AN ELECTION CRIME, INCLUDING, BUT
- 10 NOT LIMITED TO, ELECTION FRAUD OR FORGERY.

- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 1
- 2 after the date it is enacted into law.
