23 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

24 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

25 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state

1 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under
2 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018 is
3 \$178,400,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be
4 paid to local units of government is \$106,575,000.00.

5 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
6 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
7 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
8 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
9 to 18.1594.

10 **DEPARTMENT OF ATTORNEY GENERAL**

11 Sec. 250. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for attorney
12 general operations, the department of attorney general shall
13 allocate \$1,000,000.00 for the investigation into systemic issues
14 with sexual misconduct at Michigan State University.

15 **STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

16 Sec. 301. Funds appropriated in part 1 for cities and villages
17 shall be distributed among cities and villages in accordance with
18 section 13 of 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.663 to be used only for the
19 construction or preservation of city and village streets.

20 Sec. 302. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for county road
21 commissions shall be distributed among county road commissions in
22 accordance with section 12 of 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.662 to be used
23 only for the construction or preservation of county roads.

24 (2) As used in this part, "county road commission" means that
25 term as defined in section 10c of 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.660c.

1 Sec. 303. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for state trunkline
2 preservation and next generation technologies and service delivery
3 shall be used as follows:

4 (a) Not less than \$53,425,000.00 shall be used for the
5 preservation of state trunkline roads and bridges in accordance
6 with section 11 of 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.661.

7 (b) Not more than \$15,000,000.00 may be used for projects
8 related to next generation technologies, hydrogen fueling stations,
9 and service delivery, including demonstration projects related to
10 enhanced transportation services for senior citizens and persons
11 with disabilities.

12 (2) The state transportation department shall submit a report
13 to the state budget director, the chairs of the house and senate
14 committees on appropriations, the house and senate appropriations
15 subcommittees on transportation, and the house and senate fiscal
16 agencies on the use of funds appropriated for next generation
17 technologies and service delivery, including a description of
18 projects, the status of projects, and a breakdown of expenditures
19 by project. The report shall be submitted on or before March 1,
20 2019. Funds appropriated in part 1 shall not be used by a
21 governmental entity to purchase, construct, operate, or maintain a
22 communications network to provide service to any residential or
23 commercial premises. This prohibition does not apply to state
24 expenditures for a transportation purpose, connected vehicle
25 communication technologies, or other transportation related
26 activities.
