SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 822

A bill to clarify certain powers of the governor; and to impose certain duties on certain state officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Memorandum of understanding" means an informal agreement
- 3 between this state and another party that does not impose
- 4 contractual duties or obligations on this state.
- 5 (b) "Office of the great seal" means the office of the great
- 6 seal located within the executive office of the Michigan department
- 7 of state.
- 8 Sec. 2. Beginning 90 days after the effective date of this
- 9 act, before signing a memorandum of understanding, the governor
- 10 shall ensure that the memorandum of understanding contains a
- 11 provision that the memorandum of understanding is in effect only

- 1 for the time that the governor holds office as governor, unless
- 2 ratified by the successive governor. If a memorandum of
- 3 understanding is ratified by a successive governor, then that
- 4 ratification is only effective for the time that governor holds
- 5 office as governor.
- 6 Sec. 3. (1) A copy of a memorandum of understanding signed by
- 7 the governor under this act shall be filed in the office of the
- 8 great seal and made available to the public. Copies of each
- 9 memorandum of understanding under this act shall also be posted on
- 10 the department of state internet website.
- 11 (2) The department of state shall file a copy of each
- 12 memorandum of understanding under this act with each house of the
- 13 legislature and the senate majority leader, the senate minority
- 14 leader, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the
- 15 minority leader of the house of representatives.
