SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 929

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 20921b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 20921B. (1) A LIMITED AMBULANCE OPERATION WHOSE PRIMARY
- 2 SERVICE AREA IS IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF 10,000 OR LESS AND
- 3 WHOSE PRIMARY SERVICE AREA HAS A POPULATION DENSITY OF FEWER THAN 7
- 4 PEOPLE PER SQUARE MILE MAY HAVE AN AMBULANCE AVAILABLE AT LESS THAN
- 5 THE LIMITED LEVEL OF LICENSURE IF BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS
- 6 ARE MET:
- 7 (A) THE MEDICAL CONTROL AUTHORITY UNDER WHICH THE AMBULANCE
- 8 OPERATION OPERATES AUTHORIZES THE LESSER AVAILABILITY.
- 9 (B) THE AMBULANCE OPERATION HAS DEPARTMENT-APPROVED LOCAL

- 1 MEDICAL CONTROL AUTHORITY PROTOCOLS IN PLACE.
- 2 (2) A BASIC AMBULANCE OPERATION WHOSE PRIMARY SERVICE AREA IS
- 3 IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF 10,000 OR LESS AND WHOSE PRIMARY
- 4 SERVICE AREA HAS A POPULATION DENSITY OF FEWER THAN 7 PEOPLE PER
- 5 SQUARE MILE MAY OPERATE AT A LIMITED AMBULANCE OPERATION LEVEL OF
- 6 LICENSURE WHEN STAFFED WITH AN ADVANCED EMT IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 7 CONDITIONS ARE MET:
- 8 (A) THE BASIC AMBULANCE IS EQUIPPED AT THE GREATER LICENSURE
- 9 LEVEL.
- 10 (B) THE MEDICAL CONTROL AUTHORITY UNDER WHICH THE AMBULANCE
- 11 OPERATION OPERATES AUTHORIZES THE CONDITIONAL INCREASED LEVEL OF
- 12 LICENSURE.
- 13 (C) THE BASIC AMBULANCE OPERATION HAS DEPARTMENT-APPROVED
- 14 LOCAL MEDICAL CONTROL AUTHORITY PROTOCOLS IN PLACE.
