SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1178

A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act,"

(MCL 205.51 to 205.78) by adding section 4hh.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 4hh. (1) Beginning January 1, 2021, the sale of an instore consumer goods micro-fulfillment system or system parts to a retailer is exempt from the tax under this act.
 - (2) As used in this section:
 - (a) "Consumer goods" means finished goods for use primarily for personal, family, or household purposes.
 - (b) "Fulfillment of online orders" means the processing of orders from consumers that were made over the internet and the selection, assembly, storage, and staging of the consumer goods

- 2 (c) "In-store consumer goods micro-fulfillment system" means
- 3 equipment, including, but not limited to, computers, computer
- 4 software, storage systems, refrigerators, and freezers, that meets
- 5 both of the following requirements:
- 6 (i) Is used by a retailer exclusively for the fulfillment of
- 7 online orders of consumer goods for delivery to or pick up by the
- 8 consumer.
- 9 (ii) Is located in a building that is owned, leased, or used by
- 10 a retailer and in which at least half of the building's square
- 11 footage is used as an operating retail store.
- 12 (d) "System parts" means machinery, equipment, repair parts,
- 13 and computer software that are component parts of an in-store
- 14 consumer goods micro-fulfillment system.
