HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 230

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 233 (MCL 436.1233), as amended by 2020 PA 126.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 233. (1) The commission shall establish uniform prices
- 2 for the sale of alcoholic liquor by specially designated
- 3 distributors. The prices must return a gross profit to the
- 4 commission of not less than 51% and not greater than 65%. If
- 5 alcoholic liquor purchased by the commission has not met sales
- 6 standards established by the commission for 6 months, the
- 7 commission may sell the alcoholic liquor at a price to be approved
- 8 by the state administrative board.
- 9 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the commission may





- establish by rule prices for the sale of alcoholic liquor to
 hospitals, charitable institutions, and military establishments
 located in this state.
- 4 (3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, specially 5 designated distributors and on-premises licensees are entitled to a 6 17% discount from the uniform prices described in subsection (1) on 7 alcoholic liquor purchased from this state. Beginning with the 8 enactment date of the amendatory act that added this sentence until 9 12 months after the enactment date, July 1, 2020 through July 1, 10 2021 and beginning 30 days after the effective date of the 2021 11 amendatory act that amended this sentence and ending 12 months 12 after the effective date of the 2021 amendatory act that amended this sentence, on-premises licensees are entitled to a 23% discount 13 14 from the uniform prices described in subsection (1) on alcoholic 15 liquor purchased from this state.
