SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4205

A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled "Food law,"

by amending section 1111 (MCL 289.1111), as amended by 2018 PA 92.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1111. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Qualified premises" means a tasting room, as that term is defined in section 113 of the Michigan liquor control code of 1998, 1998 PA 58, MCL 436.1113.
 - (b) (a)—"Raw agricultural commodity" means any food in its raw or natural state including fruits that are washed, colored, or otherwise treated in their unpeeled natural form before marketing.
- 8 **(c)** "Regulatory authority" means the department, the local 9 health department, or the authorized representative having



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- 1 jurisdiction over the food establishment.
- 2 (d) $\frac{\text{(c)}}{\text{"Retail food establishment" means an operation that}}$
- 3 sells or offers to sell food directly to a consumer. Retail food
- 4 establishment includes both a retail grocery and a food service
- 5 establishment, but does not include a food processor.
- 6 (e) (d) "Retail grocery" means an operation that sells or
- 7 offers to sell food to consumers for off-premises consumption. Food
- 8 for off-premises consumption does not include take-out food
- 9 intended for immediate consumption.
- (f) (e) "Rules" means administrative rules promulgated under
- 11 this act pursuant to in accordance with the administrative
- 12 procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328.
- (g) (f) "Shellfish dealer" means an interstate wholesaler
- 14 handling shellfish.
- 15 **(h)** (q) "Shellfish dealer certification" means the issuance of
- 16 a numbered certificate to a person indicating that indicates that
- 17 the person is in compliance with the requirements of the guide for
- 18 the control of molluscan shellfish and that the person has
- 19 permission from the department to conduct 1 or more of the
- 20 following shellfish activities, as defined in the guide for the
- 21 control of molluscan shellfish:
- 22 (i) Shellstock shipper.
- 23 (ii) Shucker packer.
- 24 (iii) Repacker or reshipper.
- 25 (i) (h)—"Smoked fish rules" means R 285.569.1 to R 285.569.19
- 26 of the Michigan Administrative Code.
- 27 (j) (i) "Special transitory food unit" means a temporary food
- 28 establishment that is licensed to operate throughout the this state
- 29 without the 14-day limits or a mobile food establishment that is

- 1 not required to return to a commissary.
- 2 (k) (j) "Staple foods" does not include accessory foods, such
- 3 as coffee, tea, cocoa, soda, noncarbonated drinks, such as sports
- 4 drinks, punches, and flavored waters, candy, condiments, spices,
- 5 hot foods, or foods ready to go or made to take out, such as
- 6 prepared sandwiches or salads.
- 7 (1) (k) "Sulfiting agents" means any of the following:
- 8 (i) Sulfur dioxide.
- 9 (ii) Sodium sulfite.
- 10 (iii) Sodium bisulfite.
- 11 (iv) Potassium bisulfite.
- 12 (v) Sodium metabisulfite.
- 13 (vi) Potassium metabisulfite.
- (m) (l) "Temporary food establishment" means a food
- 15 establishment that operates at a fixed location for a temporary
- 16 period not to exceed 14 consecutive days.
- (n) (m) "Temporary license" means a written authorization
- 18 issued by the director to operate for a specified limited time
- 19 period.
- 20 (o) (n) "Transient tenant" means a person an individual who
- 21 rents a room in a bed and breakfast for fewer than 30 consecutive
- 22 days.
- (p) (o) "Trimming" means removing leaves, roots, and other
- 24 extraneous materials in preparation for grading, sorting, and sale
- 25 as a whole fruit or vegetable. Trimming does not remove the peel or
- 26 core and does not further cut the whole fruit or vegetable.
- 27 (q) (p) "U.S. standards for shell eggs" means "United States
- 28 Standards, Grades, and Weight Classes for Shell Eggs", AMS 56 (July
- 29 20, 2000), United States Department of Agriculture.

- 1 **(r)** (q)—"Vending company base location" means a vending 2 machine location or other food establishment required to be 3 separately licensed under section 4105(5).
- (s) (r)—"Vending machine" means a self-service device that,

 upon insertion of after inserting a coin, paper currency, token,

 card, or key, or by manual operation, dispenses a unit servings

 serving of food in bulk or in packages a package without the

 necessity of replenishing the device between each vending

 operation. Vending machine does not include any of the following:
- 10 (i) A device that dispenses only bottled or canned soft drinks; 11 other packaged nonperishable foods or beverages; or bulk ball gum, 12 nuts, and panned candies.
 - (ii) A water-dispensing water dispensing machine that is registered under chapter IV.section 4115.
- 15 **(t)** (s) "Vending machine location" means the room, enclosure, space, or area in which 1 or more vending machines are installed and operated, or a micro market.
- 18 **(u)** (t) "Wholesale" means selling other than directly to consumers.
- 20 (v) (u) "Wild game" means animals from their natural state and 21 not cultivated, domesticated, or tamed.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless House Bill No. ____ (request no. H00703'25) of the 103rd Legislature is enacted into law.



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
