THE APPARENT PROBLEM:

Several statutes still contain references to the obsolete "Department of Administration" (now the Department of Management and Budget). Legislation has been proposed to update the references.

THE CONTENT OF THE BILLS:

The bills would replace references to the Department of Administration with references to the Department of Management and Budget. <u>House Bill 4391</u> would amend the Tax Tribunal Act (MCL 205.725); <u>House Bill 4392</u> would amend the State Revenue Sharing Act (MCL 141.911); and <u>House Bill 4393</u> would amend the state boundary commission act (MCL 123.1004).

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The Department of Management and Budget reports that the bills have no fiscal implications. (5-12-87)

ARGUMENTS:

For:

H.B. 4391 ST GITT-18-877

The bills would merely update several laws by replacing obsolete references to an agency that no longer exists, the Department of Administration, with its successor agency, the Department of Management and Budget.

POSITIONS:
