A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5148 AS INTRODUCED 11-17-87

Under the Michigan Penal Code, a person must obtain a permit from the state police to have a police radio monitor in a vehicle. Peace officers and certain licensed amateur radio operators are exempted from the permit requirement. The bill would in addition exempt a technician class operator licensed by the Federal Communications Commission.
