**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5188 (SUBSTITUTE H-2)**

The School Code requires all state public schools to provide instruction on the principal modes by which dangerous communicable diseases, including Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS), are spread. The bill would amend the School Code to require that those who teach about AIDS to K-12 students have training in "Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome Education for Young People." Under the bill, the state board, in cooperation with the Department of Public Health, would be required to provide trainers for these teachers, and to develop and distribute to school districts material on the teaching of AIDS to young people.
