A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5518 AS INTRODUCED 3-22-88

The Michigan Youth Corps Act specifies that the son or daughter of an elected or appointed official of the state or of another governmental authority can not be hired under the youth corps program, and that a son or daughter of an employee of a state agency or a recipient can not be hired to work in a summer youth employment and work training program established by that department or recipient. The bill would amend the act to allow these persons to be hired, providing that the official or employee received not more than \$1,000, after taxes, from the applicable governmental authority, state department, or recipient, for the tax year in which the child was employed.

The bill would repeal a provision that specifies that the act expired on September 30, 1986.
