A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5537 AS INTRODUCED 4-12-88

The bill would authorize the Department of Natural Resources, on behalf of the state, to convey to the Lenawee County drain commissioner two parcels of land, each of which is approximately one-third of an acre in area, for the consideration of \$1. The conveyance would be by quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general, and the bill would specify that the land could only be used for public drainage purposes. The bill would reserve to the state all mineral rights, and any revenue received under the bill would have to be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
