CPA EXAMINATION ELIGIBILITY

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5569 AS INTRODUCED 4-21-88

The Occupational Code governs the licensing and regulation certified public accountants (CPA). The bill would amend the act to specify that a person who applied for a certificate of examination as a CPA would be considered to have fulfilled the educational requirements of the act if he or she is scheduled to receive his or her baccalaureate degree, with a in accounting, its equivalent, from an educational concentration or institution recognized by the State Board of Accountancy within 60 days after the date of the examination. The date for the fulfillment of an applicant's baccalaureate degree would have to be certified by the chief academic officer of the educational institution.

The bill would take effect May 1, 1988.
