A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5634 AS INTRODUCED 5-17-88

Under the Social Welfare Act, providers must certify as true any claims for payment for services. The act currently allows a Medicaid invoice submitted in claim for payment for services to include the indelible written name of the provider on the certification form. If a person other than the provider signs the provider's name on the form, the person's name must be included in the certification form. The bill would amend the act to require that the provider certify a claim for a Medicaid invoice, or other form submitted in claim for payment for services, by using the provider's handwritten signature. No other person could sign for a provider.
