A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5667 AS INTRODUCED 5-25-88

The bill would amend the Social Welfare Act to allow the director of the Department of Social Services to take action, under certain circumstances, to suspend, terminate, or refuse to enroll providers of medical services to medically indigent persons. The director could take action against providers who submitted duplicate claims for services, supplies, or equipment for which they had already received reimbursement from another source and after receiving notice from the department to stop submitting duplicate claims. The director could also take action against providers who, after receiving a Medicaid payment, accepted reimbursement from another source and did not refund the appropriate portion of the Medicaid payment to the department.
