A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 5732, 5734 AND 5735 AS INTRODUCED 6-2-88

The bills would amend three public acts to change statutory language which currently refers to the Energy Administration (in the Department of Commerce) to refer instead to the Public Service Commission.

Currently, if energy conservation improvements are made by villages or counties, the village council or the county board of commissioners is required to report certain information (regarding the improvements made and the estimated energy savings) to the Energy Administration of the Department of Commerce. Language in three public acts which refers to the Energy Administration would be changed to refer instead to the Public Service Commission.

House Bill 5732 would amend Public Act 286 of 1964, which governs county boards of commissioners. (MCL 46.11c)

House Bill 5734 would amend Public Act 3 of 1895, which governs general law villages. (MCL 68.36)

House Bill 5735 would amend Public Act 278 of 1909, which governs home rule villages. (MCL 78.24b)
