**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5747 AS INTRODUCED 6-7-88**

The bill would amend the Hunting and Fishing Licensing Act to provide that a resident who had been determined by the Veterans Administration of the federal government to have a service-connected total or permanent total disability rating for compensation or was receiving disability retirement pay from a branch of the uniformed armed services would be eligible to purchase a senior citizen hunting or fishing license, or both. The director of the Department of Natural Resources could demand proof of eligibility under the bill. The bill would require the licensee to possess proof of eligibility when hunting or fishing and to furnish the proof upon the request of a law enforcement or conservation officer.
